## HIV

### HIV is most commonly transmitted by:

- Having sex without using condoms or medication to prevent HIV.
- Sharing needles, syringes, or other drug injection equipment.
- HIV can pass from mother to child during pregnancy, childbirth or nursing without HIV treatment.

**Successful treatment of HIV can prevent transmission!**

## Hepatitis C

### Hepatitis C is most commonly transmitted by:

- Sharing needles, syringes, or other drug injection equipment.
- Accidental needle sticks.
- Receiving blood-based medical treatments prior to 1992.
- Sexual transmission is rare but possible.

**Successful treatment can cure HCV infection!**

## Syphilis

### Syphilis is most commonly transmitted by:

- Sexually activity (vaginal, anal. or oral sex) with a partner who has a syphilis infection.
- The presence of sores, rashes or ulcers may indicate syphilis infection though are not always present.

**Syphilis can be cured with treatment, but you can get it again if exposed!**
